Dr Stephen Billett is Professor of Adult and Vocational Education in the School of Education and Professional Studies at Griffith University, Australia. He has researched learning through and for work and has published widely in fields of learning of occupations, workplace learning, work and conceptual accounts of learning for vocational purposes.

Stephen Billett has a long term collaborated on learning with researchers at different Universities in Sweden. He is visiting Jönköping University in November, and we would like to introduce him to a wider group than our team, as many could benefit from his knowledge.



The presentation on the seminar draws on two investigations undertaken in small to medium size enterprises in Singapore and how the processes of innovation were initiated, supported, enacted and evaluated, and the reciprocal learning that arose.
