1. Your full legal name (**Ture Testsson**)
Note: The name on the document you submit must match this.
2. The name of the educational institution at which you are enrolled or employed (**Jönköping University**)
Note: The school name on the document you submit must match this.
3. A date within the current school term.

Preferred documents include:


- Transcript
- School-issued confirmation letter
- A copy of your student ID (photo ID not required)



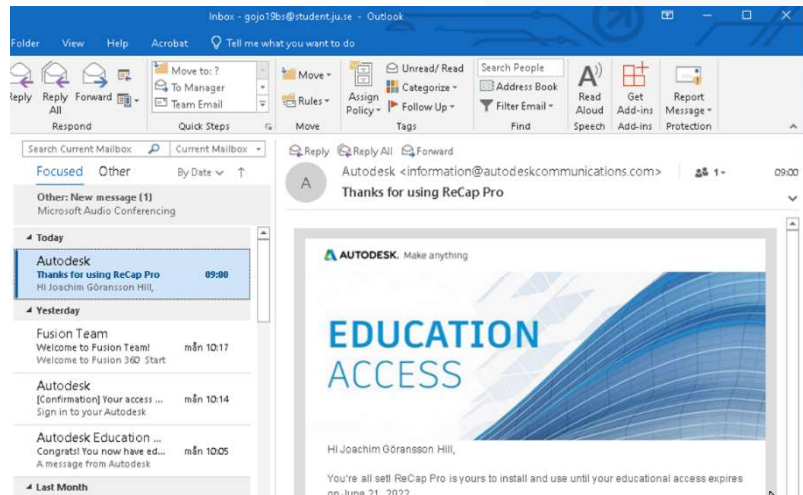
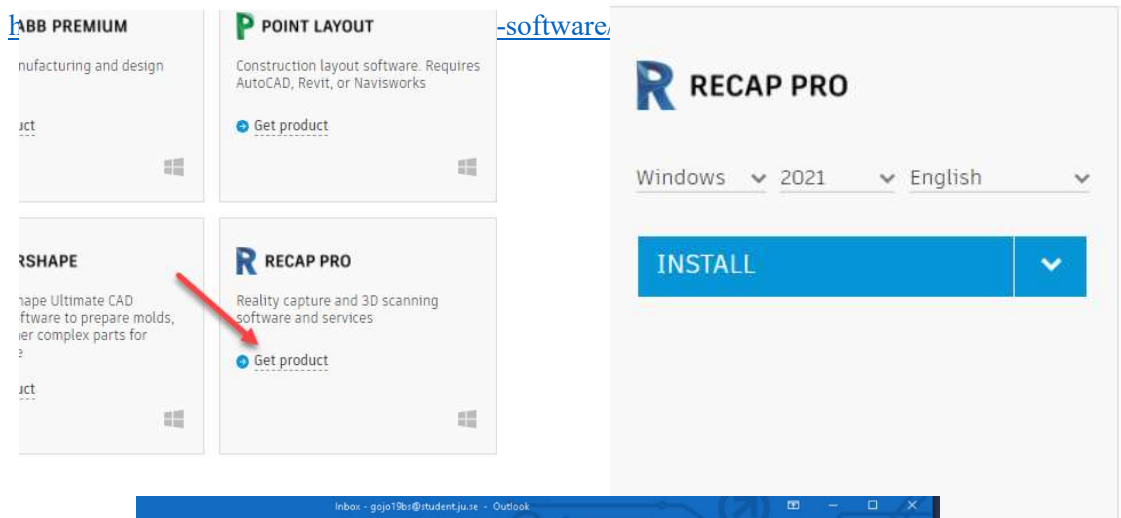
